



DATA PROTECTION POLICY

Personal Identification Information

We may collect personal identification information from Users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when Users visit our website, register on the website, become a member, respond to a survey, fill out a form, and in connection with other activities, services, features or resources we make available. Users may visit our website anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from Users only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can always refuse to supply personally identification information, except that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website related activities.

Information That Is Gathered From Visitors

In common with other websites, log files are stored on the web server saving details such as the visitor's IP address, browser type, referring page and time of visit. This information is not used to track individual visitors to this website.

You may be able to block cookies via your browser settings but this may prevent you from access to certain features of the website.

Sharing Your Personal Information

We do not sell, trade, or rent users personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates and advertisers for the purposes outlined above. We may share your information with

How We Protect Your Information
