Two robots have been repositioned to side of the 1st tee. This has had a massive impact on the efficiency of those robots. To the extent that robots are now idle.

The programming of the robots is being improved. Several improvements to the 3rd were made and additional new areas by the 8th tee were included.

The rear rough of the 9th has been a great success and I can start to see the consistency of cut. We have a new 10mm spacer from Kress which is a game changer. I would recommend that the programming be repeated with the new spacer at some point. This will improve efficiency.

We are starting to work on the back 9 with the first robot coming out to play in early July. We will push all the lessons learnt into the 18th and 17th semi rough

areas.
